“Friendship Starburst” Example is “Sofa” size



A beautiful four patch block with an incidental star in the corners. The pattern makes use of eight different colorful fabrics and a “star” fabric to create a joyful creation.

We will be using an Easy Angle to create our stars. Bring your Easy Angle, or there will be plenty to share at your table.

Fabrics for this quilt could be: Monotone as above, or a great stash buster. You could use Christmas Fabrics, or children’s fabrics. How about sports team colors or summer flowers? Star fabric should be distinct from other fabrics, lightest tones.

Other fabrics should be a good mix of darker tones and mid-tones.

The blocks are made with all 2½” strips, feel free to bring jelly rolls or fat quarters!

Finished size: Crib size to King size. You decide!

Fabric needed: All measurements are full length of fabric.

“Lots of Squares” Table Runner or Placemats.



Great project for a beginner quilter!

It is very possible to finish this in one weekend.

Think seasonal fabrics as you plan this: Christmas, Fall, Birthday, Spring, Easter, 4th of July.

Finished size: Table Runner: 14” x 42”. Placemats: 8@ 17” x 14”

Fabric needed: All measurements are full length of fabric.

Table Runner (coordinating fabrics)

Remember: contrast of color is so pretty!

Fabric A: $\frac{1}{6}$ yard

Fabric B: $\frac{1}{2}$ yard

Fabric C: $\frac{1}{6}$ yard

Fabric D: $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

Backing Fabric: 1 yard

Batting: 15” x 46”, 80/20 blend recommended

Thread: One spool, color to match

Placemats (coordinating fabrics) Eight Finished Placemats

Remember: contrast of color is so pretty!

Fabric A: $\frac{2}{3}$ yard

Fabric B: $1\frac{1}{2}$ yard

Fabric C: $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

Fabric D: $\frac{2}{3}$ yard

Backing: $1\frac{3}{4}$ yard

Batting: “Crib Size” bat, 80/20 blend recommended

Thread: One spool, color to match
