

2025 Family Weekend FAQs

Registration and Check In:

1. How do we register?

Call the office to register: (320) 732 - 3218

2. What does check in look like?

Check-in for all lodging areas is at the Welcome Center near the entrance of camp. Final payment will be collected when checking in.

Campgrounds: Friday 2 PM - 7 PM

Cabins: Friday 3 PM - 7 PM

3. What if we need to arrive after 7 PM?

Campsite assignments will be hung on the door of the Welcome Center. Guests arriving after 7 PM can locate their campsite and settle their bill with the campground host before departing camp.

4. What does check out and departure look like?

As we welcome new youth summer campers to property on the Sundays that follow these retreats, guests are to depart by 12 PM. Access to the main camp also concludes at 12 PM.

5. What if I want to come a day early?

Guests may register to arrive on Thursday instead of Friday but please keep the following in mind:

1. Early arrivals cannot be accommodated for those in Lakeside campground, Edlund, or any of the cabins.
2. Guests arriving Thursday may check in starting at 2 PM in the Welcome Center.
3. Access to the main camp (anything to the North of Westwood playground) for guests is not until 12 PM on Friday. This includes the beach, the backfield, the gym, the Dining Hall and Lakeview South, cabins, Lakeside campground, gaga, 9 square, etc.

What to know before arrival:

1. What is provided at campsites and cabins?

A picnic table and fire ring. Firewood is provided free of charge and is found at several convenient locations. Please do not bring firewood to Camp. Cabin guests need to bring their own bedding and towels. Modern bathrooms with showers are located in the cabin area, just a short walk from cabins.

2. Where will we eat?

Households will need to bring supplies to prepare and cook their own meals at campsites and cabins.

3. Can we bring beer, wine, or liquor? What about smoking?

Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on LBBC grounds. Smoking is permitted only in personal vehicles or outside camp buildings.

4. Can we bring a dog?

Dogs:

- are welcome at your campsite and outdoors at your cabin.
- must be registered via our [online form](#) prior to arrival, or upon arrival.
- will be kenneled or leashed at all times.
- will be personally attended to at all times (do not leave at campsite or cabin).
- are not allowed inside buildings (exception: registered service animal).
- waste must be bagged up and disposed of properly.

5. Do campsites have full hookups?

Mill Point – electric (50 amp), water, sewer. Onboard bathrooms recommended.

Cottonwood – electric (50 amp), water

Westwood – electric (50 amp)

Lakeside – light electric (10 amp). Lakeside has its own bathroom.

NOTE: The Westwood Bathroom currently serves Westwood, Cottonwood & Mill Point.

6. Does camp have a dump station?

Yes. The dump station is located across from the Welcome Center.

7. Can we use our personal vehicles to get around camp?

Yes. Speed Limit is 10 mph. Passengers need to be inside vehicles. For your safety, passengers in a truck bed must be sitting completely down in the bed with the tailgate up (riding on running boards, trailers, etc. are not allowed). No golf carts can be used on site. Guests with mobility issues may use golf carts but must call camp for approval.

8. Can we bring a boat?

Yes. The public access is across the lake on Hummingbird Road. Trailer parking is available in designated areas at Camp. Limited docking space. Check in at office.

9. Is ice available?

5 lb bags of ice are available on the Welcome Center porch for \$3 each. CASH ONLY.

10. Will the Welcome Center be open all weekend?

The Welcome Center will be open during check in on Friday from 2 pm to 7 pm and again on Sunday from 8 am to 10 am. Instead of having the Welcome Center open on Saturday, we will be having LBBC staff as campground hosts staying in SOWER site #1. They will be camping alongside guests for the weekend and available to assist guests as needs arise.
